With the support of Muhammad Subuh Foundation, SD Canada, SD France, SD Britain, SD Ireland, SD Netherlands, SD Norway and many donors, SDIA completed the funding needs for Phase 1 of its partnership with African Doctors (Médecins d'Afrique) to develop a community owned-and-operated Health Centre (CSCOM) in the Ndijili Kilambu District. The CSCOM will provide primary health care for 17,000 inhabitants of the local health zone, who currently have poor access to affordable, quality healthcare.

Support from the Muhammad Subuh Foundation was provided to ensure that funding was available for scholarships in 2010. The Subud Education Fund was set up under the umbrella of the WSA to help Subud members and their families gain access to education at any level, from primary to higher or vocational education, or in-job training. Applications are screened by a committee and the most deserving are given subsidies (between US\$200 and US\$1,000), within the amount available, and whenever there is no other bursary or scholarship available in their country.
